**Introduction:** As we approach the halfway point of our Lenten journey, we hear in today's Gospel how Jesus was also in the middle of a journey. He knew what it is to feel helpless, parched and weary. Understanding human need, Jesus offers an experience of God's Spirit to quench our deepest longings.

**First Reading** Exodus 17:3-7 - The Israelites, dying of thirst in the desert, begin to doubt God's love for them. At God's command, Moses strikes the rock with his staff. Out gushes water.

Second Reading Romans 5:1-2. 5-8

God's love is overflowing: that is why Christ came to save us, and not because we deserved it. Trusting in God's love, we face the future with hope.

**Gospel** John 4:5-42 - The conversion of Samaria begins when Jesus stops by a well, where he meets a woman coming to draw water. She gives him a drink; he, in turn, offers her the living water of God's Spirit.
