Introduction: The solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, more commonly known as Corpus Christi, is a wonderful way of gathering together the themes of Easter. The Eucharist has been described as summing up everything we do and profess as Christians.

First Reading Exodus 24:3-8 - The importance of blood, shed for the good of others. Israelites give this gift to God from their own flocks and herds – an offering of life to God, the Lord of life

Second Reading Hebrews 9:11-15 - Unlike the multiple sacrifices in the past, the sacrifice of Jesus is a once-and-for-all sacrifice.

Gospel Mark 14:12-16. 22-26 - Mark's account of the Last Supper and the institution of Eucharist: an action whereby Jesus' gift of himself is made available in every age.
